it speaks about any subject, regardless of social or political agenda; it absorbs and brings to stage every culture and mindset; it survived millenniums, every war and every regime.*

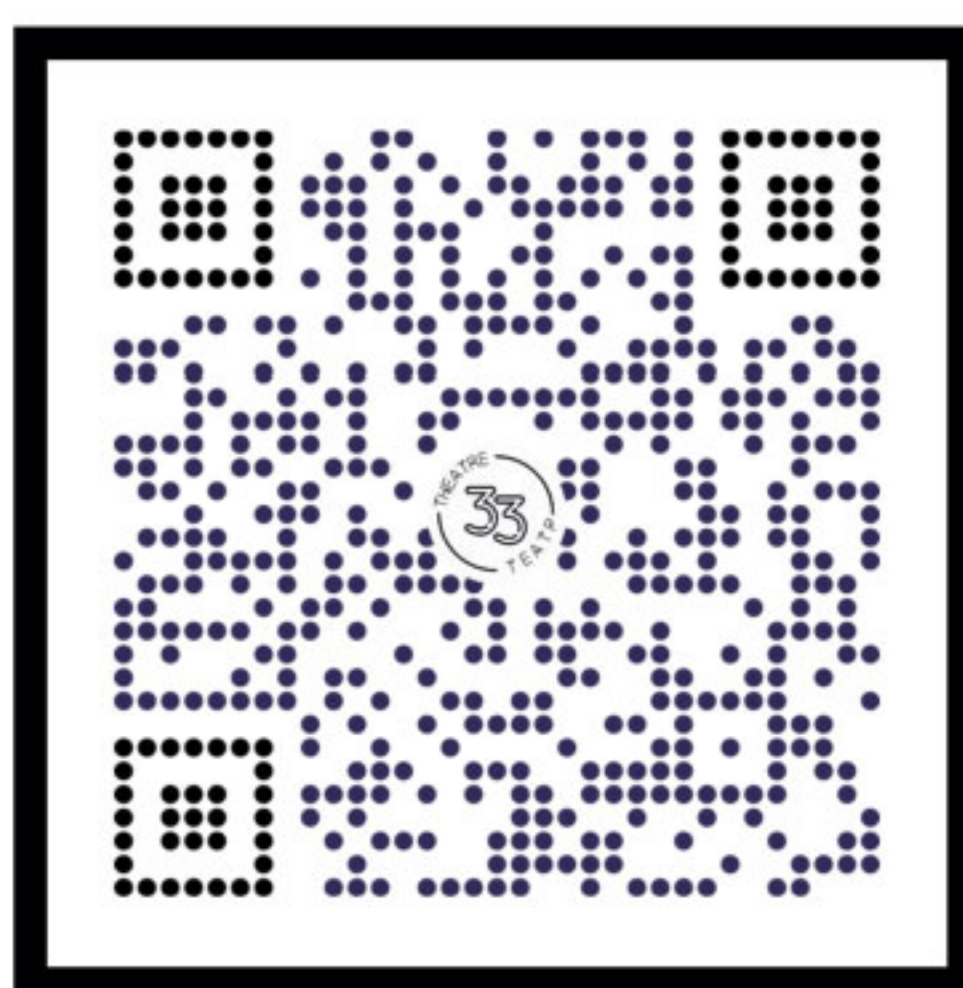
*Theatre still speaks from the hearts of creators to the hearts of the audience and will continue to exist while there is at least one actor and one spectator.
